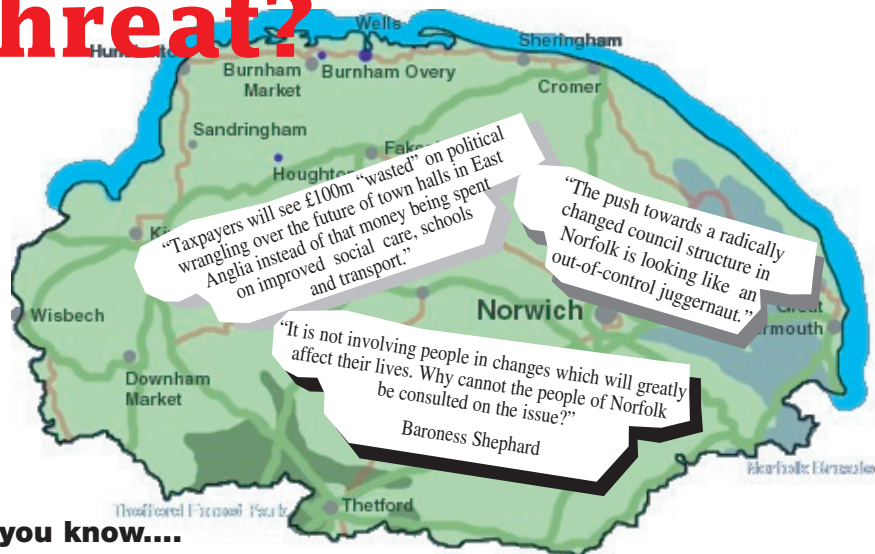


# Did you know that Norfolk is under threat?

- that in addition to threatening our Post Offices and our coastal defences in Norfolk, the Labour Government is imposing local government reorganisation in your area - and you are not going to be asked your opinion about it?
- Last year, the government ordered our County and District councils in Norfolk to draw up plans to reorganise themselves on unitary lines. They said that we can not keep the system we have — "the status quo is not an option."
- Despite their objections, our councils have had to spend nearly a million pounds of your money to prepare plans for a reorganisation they do not want, and on which you have not been consulted.
- The Boundary Committee, the body charged by the government with the task of imposing this reorganisation on the people of Norfolk has said "public opinion is only one factor in the process"
- If this unwanted reorganisation is allowed to proceed, we could have chaos for years at local level, with all the services, education, social services, roads and waste disposal being dismantled and put together again, with you, the council tax payer footing the bill.
- We might end up with 3 or 4 County Halls, 3 or 4 Chief Education officers, 3 or 4 Social Services chiefs, at huge cost which will have to be met from your council taxes.
